Ellyne Wieringa Biography 2024

Ellyne (1993) is a pianist with a sense of warmth and colour in her playing. In addition to her focus on Dutch composers, she is open to interdisciplinary musical creations. She studied with Bart van de Roer (Codarts, Rotterdam) and Paul Komen (Prince Claus Conservatory, Groningen). She has also trained with the Scholtes-Janssens Piano Duo and participated in, among others, the chamber music masterclass Jeunesses Musicales (Weikersheim, Germany).

Ellyne has collaborated with Wiecher Mandemaker, Arie van Beek, Stef Collignon and the Rotterdam Symphony Chorus, Codarts Symphony Orchestra and the Nijmegen Strijkersgilde with whom she soloed with Shostakovich's first piano concerto.

Ellyne programs chamber music concerts and gives young professionals a stage in the Rietveld Theater (Delft). Ellyne is a teacher at Codarts, and the Codarts Lyceum (main subject piano and chamber music for young talent).

As a soloist and chamber musician, she has received several recognitions and scholarships. With support from Stichting Eigen Muziekinstrument, she was able to realize her dream of purchasing a Steinway & Sons concert grand piano.
